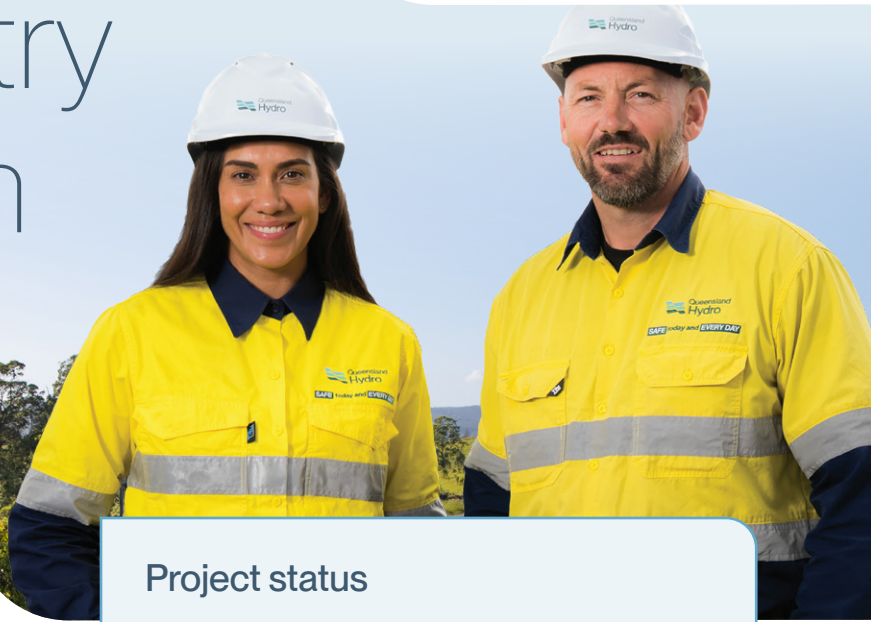

Project status

The project is currently in exploratory works stage. Exploratory works are critical activities that will confirm geotechnical conditions and characteristics of the Borumba Project site, which will inform detail design.

Planned exploratory works include:



exploratory tunnel drilling



constructing new access tracks



geotechnical investigations



supporting infrastructure



minor road improvements



establishing spoil stockpile areas

Local interest

Examples of goods and services local small-to-medium enterprises and First Nations businesses may be able to supply include:



Civil, earthworks and materials

Earthworks, access roads, drainage and culverts, quarry materials, aggregates, concrete, fencing and road maintenance



Safety and site support

PPE and workwear, safety signage and barriers, traffic control, cleaning, waste and spoil management, site consumables and fuel



Plant and logistics

Wet and dry plant hire, trucking, and heavy haulage operators

Surveying, environmental support, local trade and labour support

Supply directly to Queensland Hydro

Queensland Hydro uses VendorPanel to manage all public tenders for goods and services supplied directly to Queensland Hydro. You can view the current tenders by searching for “Queensland Hydro” via QTenders at qtenders.hpw.qld.gov.au.


To supply directly to Queensland Hydro, you will first need to register on the VendorPanel Marketplace. Once your profile is active, you can be invited to tender and will have full access to view and respond to public opportunities as they are released.

3. Register as a supplier and request invitation.
4. Follow instructions to complete registration.
5. Be sure to register for Marketplace Lists and turn on email notifications to receive alerts for future tender opportunities.
6. Submit your tender for opportunities as they become available.

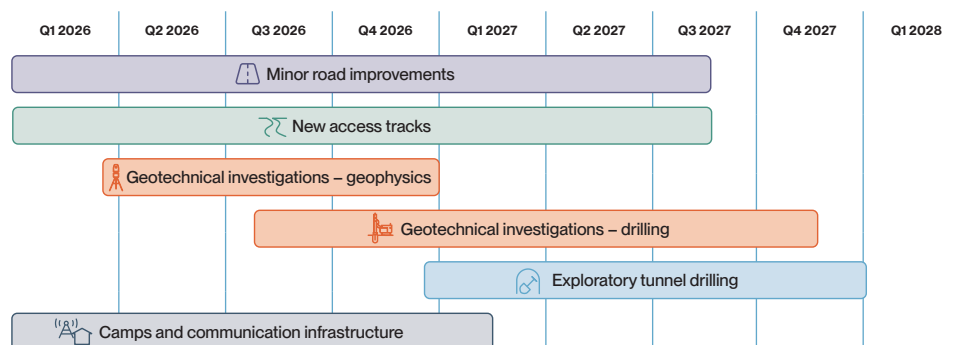
