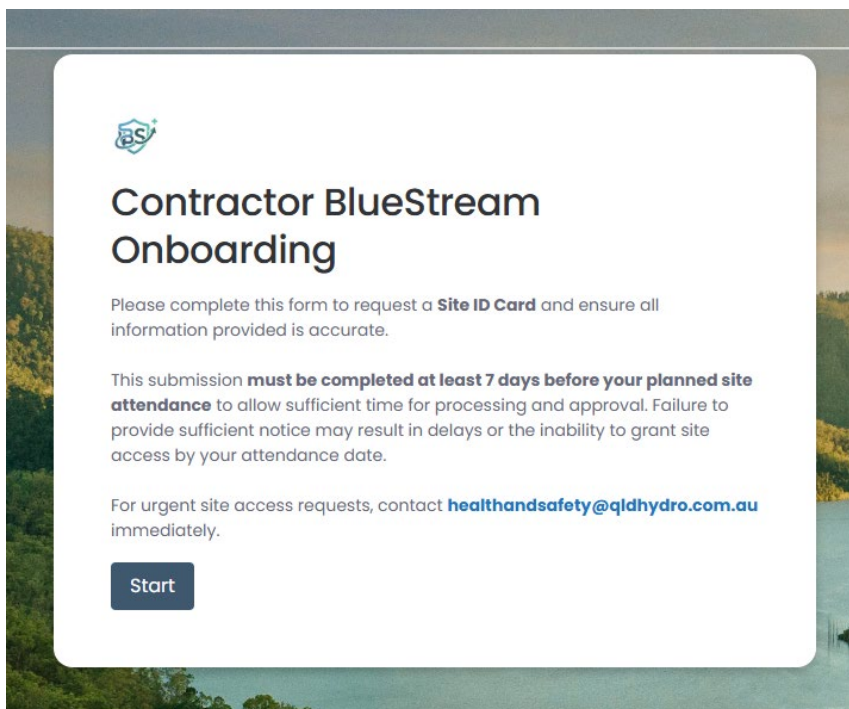


BlueStream Onboarding Process

Submit your details for BlueStream Onboarding

1. You will submit your details to the BlueStream admin team via the [Contractor BlueStream Onboarding Request](#) form.



The onboarding form collects your name, contact details, and any licences or certifications relevant to the work you will perform on site.

All workers must provide evidence of a General Construction Induction Card, commonly referred to as a White Card, before they can be onboarded into BlueStream.

Note: A White Card statement of attainment is only accepted as evidence of competency for 60 days from the date of issue. After this period, you must provide evidence of the physical White Card.

2. Once the form has been submitted, you will receive an email from BlueStream@qldhydro.com.au confirming that your submission is under review. The Health and Safety team will review your licences and certifications to confirm they are valid and current before onboarding can proceed.

If a licence or certification is not valid or current, you will be contacted by BlueStream@qldhydro.com.au and asked to provide updated evidence or rectify the issue.

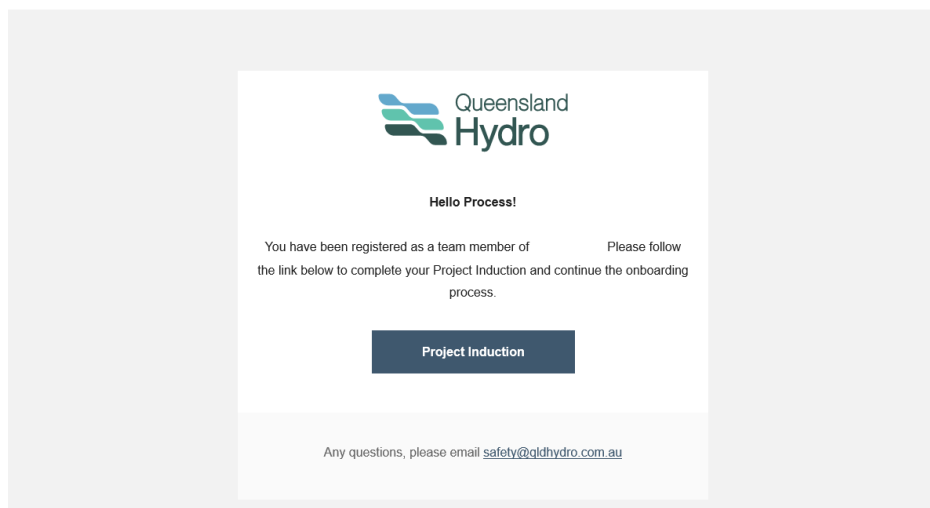
Once all required licences and certifications have been approved, the Queensland Hydro BlueStream team will create your BlueStream profile.

Your BlueStream Profile and Project Induction Email

- Once your BlueStream profile has been created, you will receive an email from BlueStream@qldhydro.com.au with the subject line **You have been approved for onboarding**.

This email includes a link to complete *The Project Induction*, which you must complete as part of the onboarding process. A reference image of the email is provided below.
